1. Organizer

2. Participation and Procedure

Participants enter the challenge by fulfilling the terms and conditions of participation. This specifically involves properly completing the entry form. The entry form provided by Doppstadt must be completed in full, truthfully, and legibly, and submitted to the organizer by the deadline. Incomplete or incorrectly filled-out entry forms may be excluded from participation.

Participation takes place during the opening hours set by IFAT. Participation in the challenge is free of charge. No paid services need to be used.

3. Eligibility

All individuals aged 18 or older are eligible to participate. A prerequisite for participation is that the participant’s registered office is located in Germany. If the place of performance or fulfillment differs from the registered office, it must also be located within Germany.

The designated service location must have paved access roads and be suitable for the performance of the service. In particular, a paved, level installation area suitable for heavy-duty traffic with a minimum size of approximately 30 × 30 meters must be provided.

Responsibility for the operation of the facility in compliance with waste management and environmental regulations, as well as for obtaining all necessary permits, lies exclusively with the winner of the demonstration.

The implementation date will be determined in consultation with the relevant contacts at the organizer (MMPC).

Employees of the organizer are excluded from participation.

4. Scoring and Determination of Winners

The winner will be selected by random drawing. The winner will be chosen after IFAT and notified.

5. Disqualification from the Contest

In the event of violations of the rules of participation or attempts at fraud, the organizer reserves the right to disqualify participants from the contest.

6. No Affiliation with Social Media Platforms

This contest is not affiliated with Instagram, Facebook, or any other platforms and is in no way sponsored, endorsed, or organized by them.

7. Legal Recourse

Legal recourse is excluded. A cash payment of the prize is not possible.
